

SMALL GRANT AGREEMENT

and

CONGOLESE UNION OF HIV/AIDS ORGANIZATIONS (UCOP PLUS)

A registered Non-Profit Association under the Laws of the Democratic Republic of Congo situated at Intersection of Libération and Triomphal Blvd Avenues, (PNMLS Building, Room 10, Democratic Republic of Congo, and herein represented by Ange Mavula in his capacity as National Executive Secretary, he being duly authorized hereto.

(hereinafter referred to as "the Institution")

in respect of

"IMPAACT4HIV" - IMPROVED ACCESS TO AHD CARE AND TREATMENT 4HIV"

(hereinafter referred to as "the Project")

1. PURPOSE OF GRANT

1.1. To implement innovative, human-centered, and community-informed approaches to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of delivering AHD care.

2. COMMENCEMENT AND DURATION

2.1. This agreement shall become effective from **01 January 2025** to **31 December 2025**, unless terminated earlier or extended in accordance with the contractual terms and conditions contained in this agreement.

3. PROJECT ACTIVITIES AND OUTPUTS

- 3.1. The project activities shall be implemented in accordance with:
 - 3.1.1. AHD Project Proposal as set out in Annexure "A";
 - 3.1.2. MPOX Project Proposal as set out in Annexure "B";
 - 3.1.3. AHD Milestones and Objectives as set out in Annexure "C";
 - 3.1.4. MPOX Milestones and Objectives as set out in Annexure "D";
 - 3.1.5. AHD Project Budget as set out in Annexure "E"; and
 - 3.1.6. MPOX Project Budget as set out in Annexure "F".
- 3.2. Any changes to the documents incorporated as Annexure's "A" through "F" hereto, shall require the prior written approval of AURUM.

4. APPROVED FUNDING

4.1. **AURUM** agrees to provide **the Institution** with a grant in the amount of **\$70,000** (Seventy Thousand USD) for **12 months** (One Year).

5. BUDGET

5.1. The Institution's final and approved budget and scope of work for the funding for the project is annexed hereto as **Annexures** "E" and "F" respectively and will be used in accordance with the contractual terms and conditions contained in this agreement.

6. DISBURSEMENTS

6.1. The funding will be disbursed on a milestone basis, within 15 (fifteen) business days from the date of receipt of a valid tax invoice from the Institution as specified in 6.1.1 below.

7. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

7.1. By accepting payment for this grant, the Institution agrees and consents to the following conditions of the grant:

- 7.1.1. The Institution is accountable for the tasks specified in the agreement and the defined scope of work.
- 7.1.2. The Institution must adhere to the timeline and the deadlines stated in this agreement.
- 7.1.3. The Institution must perform their work with diligence and efficiency, maintaining high moral and ethical standards, and exercising the care and skill consistent with professional norms.
- 7.1.4. In the event that AURUM determines that the Institution is not meeting its obligations, AURUM shall provide the Institution 20 (twenty) days of receipt of written notice to remedy such breach or failure.

- 7.1.5. If the Institution fails to comply with such notice, AURUM shall forthwith be entitled, but not obliged, without prejudice to any other rights or remedies to cancel the agreement.
- 7.1.6. The Institution must maintain accurate financial records, original receipts, and other relevant information, in accordance with international accounting practices.
- 7.1.7. The Institution agrees to provide AURUM with originals of all supporting documents.,
- 7.1.8. If the Institution significantly transfers assets, merges, or becomes insolvent, they must promptly notify AURUM, understanding that such events may lead to the termination of further funding.
- 7.1.9. The Institution must avoid any actions that could negatively impact AURUM including its operations, employee safety, security, and reputation, and must fulfil its commitments with AURUM's best interests in mind.
- 7.1.10. The Institution must comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations relevant to their obligations under this Agreement, including those concerning copyright and intellectual property.
- 7.1.11. The Institution must ensure that their personnel also respect and comply with these laws, rules and regulations.
- 7.1.12. The Institution and/or the Institution's Appointed Project Director(s), via written notification to AURUM, agrees to make full disclosure to AURUM of any conflict of interest that it has or that it believes may arise in the future in respect of the Project.
- 7.1.13. The Institution agrees to make full disclosure to AURUM of any Project Intellectual Property (IP) or potential IP which results from any and /or all activities undertaken in the project and which is funded by Donor, within 60 (sixty) days of signature of this Agreement.
